## Administrative Items:

The meeting was called to order by Roger Corrado at 7 PM.

- Membership health concerns Gary Cummings and Boude family.
- March BOD minutes approved by the Board.
- Sharing of Ideas with Other Clubs via FFF (Steve Bailey) Steve is waiting on possible interest from FFF.
- Open Positions (Roger Corrado) We are still in need of a Program Director. Randy Clark is conduct a survey at the September meeting to gather input on ideas for future speakers and see if there is interest in serving as Program Director (see March minutes regarding support available for a new Program Director). Also, we need to start looking for a new membership chairman as Dick Naber has his house up for sale and wants to move to Florida. If we get a volunteer Dick has offered to train him.
