BUFF Board of Directors Meeting Minutes April 16, 2014

Administrative Items/Proposals

The meeting was called to order by President Ken Dixon at 6:32 pm at the Springdale Community Center.

- March 19, 2014 BOD meeting minutes A motion was made by Bob Gustafson, seconded by Tom Smith to accept the minutes as written. The motion passed.
- March 21, 2014 BOD vote An email was sent to the Board on 3/20/14 requesting approval for a donation of \$100 to the Clermont Soil and Water Conservation District for supplies for the 2014 Spring Litter Clean-up to be held May 3rd. That request was voted on via email, and passed on 3/21/14.
- Fly Show No report this month.
- Change to Article III of the Bylaws The membership vote on the change will be undertaken at the May 14 Membership Meeting. Per the Bylaws, there will need to be a quorum of at least 60 members (two different Club Trips are scheduled for the same time). Duane Bentley will provide ballots.
- Banquet Committee Update Jeff McElravy
 A meeting has been held and summary notes recorded. Jeff reviewed the notes with the Board. Jeff will have another meeting with the team before the next BOD Meeting and provide the committee's recommendation to the Board.
- Screen Shots & Announcements Pete Moore / Duane Bentley
 Pete provided material to the Board prior to the meeting and he and Duane
 reviewed the objectives and proposals. A discussion followed by the entire Board
 with many suggestions and positive inputs. Ken Foltz also recommended putting
 each month's announcements on the BUFF Web Site for reference after the monthly
 meeting. Duane Bentley will release an email to a larger group of potential
 announcement creators, providing the template and instructions. All

announcements for the May 14th meeting must be received by Pete and Duane by the end of April.

BugFest 2014 – Bryan Tudor / Ed Jones / Jim Neckers
 An email had been sent to the BOD prior to the meeting. BUFF has been invited to attend and provide fly fishing information. The event will occur on June 7 from 10 am to 3 pm at the Cincinnati Museum, at the Union Terminal. Bryan provided a handout listing 10 BUFF volunteers and the assigned areas of their support.

Chair Reports:

Treasurer's Report – Bob Gustafson

- The financial reports through March were sent out in advance. Total Income through 3/31 is \$35,453 and Total Expenses are \$24,574. The Club has Total Current Assets of \$38, 480. There has been \$220 received as donations from the Fischer Memorial. Jeff
 McElravy made a motion, seconded by Steve Walker to approve the March financial report. The motion was approved.
- The 2013 audit of the books was conducted on 3/31 by Steve Bailey and Steve Alexander. A report was provided to the BOD by email and discussed by Steve Bailey. The Audit Committee found no material errors or omissions and stated that the 2013 financial statements fairly represent the financial position of the Club. There was one recommendation that the BOD review and consider additional measures for cash deposits. The Board discussed the recommendation and expressed its appreciation to both the Audit Committee and to Bob Gustafson for their service. Tom Agin made a motion, seconded by Tom Smith to approve the Audit Committee's Report. The motion was approved.
- Discussion ensued on sharing the Club's financial records at a Membership Meeting.
 Bob Gustafson will develop slides for review with membership.
- Bob reviewed the 2013 year-end excess cash worksheet for use in determining the
 extent of contributions to appropriate organizations this year. No action was taken at
 this time. The May Board Meeting will be targeted for further review and approval.

Membership – Tom Agin

Tom reported a total of 270 BUFF memberships to date, 182 single and 88 family. A total of 63 did not renew this year and have been dropped from the membership role. There have been 38 new members received through the first four months of 2014.

Communications – Tom Smith

The April Buffer is out. The May Buffer articles are due by Monday April 21.

Bob Fischer's fly fishing equipment is to be donated by Bob's widow to the club for auction. An article will be placed in the *Buffer* and on the BUFF Web Site for next two months. Bob Jones is close to the Fischer family and is the focal point with the Club for that exchange. Bob proposed the auction be undertaken at the BUFF Meeting in June. Bob Gustafson will investigate the amount and kinds of equipment through Bob Jones.

- Don outlined the new capability through the web site for the Board of Directors to provide an email blast.
- Online purchases of logo items Jeff McElravy; nothing new to report at this time.

Trips – Steve Bailey
