Administrative Items:

- Membership health concerns? Is there anyone we need to send a card to?
- March BOD meeting minutes approval
 - Motion to approve the March 2016 was proposed by Sue Jones and seconded by Ed Jones. The motion passed.
- Treasurer's Report (Bob G.)
 - Income through March was \$34,807 (@99% of budget) and expenses were \$22,580 (61% of forecast); Club Assets are \$45,240.
 - The BUFF policy is that checks over \$1,500 require two signatures. Paul Juszczyk as the new VP will need to sign signature card.
 - Philanthropy: Proposal for philanthropy of \$6,600 for this year was recommended to the BOD. This is the highest amount over the last five years and reflects the high income for this year.

 - Louise Goldsbery is donating many items including fly tying equipment and supplies.
 - Bette Haynes has donated additional fly tying equipment and supplies
- Donations Issues (Sue Jones)
 - A guideline for what is accepted and the rights of disposition of donated items is needed. A committee consisting of Ken Spiker, Joe Panfalone and Tim Mitton will create a proposal.
- LMC Smallmouth Sonny Donation (JR Jackson)
 - Smallmouth Sonny Project needs to be decided and sent prior to May when the book goes to press. \$300 donation is proposed. Tim Mitton motioned to donate \$300 to the Sonny Project. Don Kail seconded the motion. The motion passed.

- BUFF Discretionary Fund (JR Jackson)
 - JR recommended the following change to dues: "BUFF Membership Dues for a given individual or family can be waived under circumstances deemed appropriate by the Membership Chairman and the President (e.g. an otherwise active and engaged member of the club under extreme financial hardship)."
 - A motion to waive BUFF membership as outlined above was proposed by Steve Bailey and seconded by Ed Jones. The motion carried.

 - o June 4th Bugfest 4 volunteers needed
 - Lake Isabella fish camp is 3 weeks in June. A couple of people are needed for about 1 hour each time
 - o Debbie Stewart is the new contact for VOA.
 - We have understanding with VOA that BUFF will help with three events per year.
