The meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm by president, Jim Vota.

## **Administrative Items:**

- Membership health concerns? Is there anyone we need to send a card to?
  - Ken Speicher wife
- February BOD meeting Minutes approval
  - Jeff McElravy motioned to accept March's Minutes. The motion was seconded by Don Kail. The motion carried.
- Treasurer's Report (Bob G.)
  - Financial reports through March were emailed ahead of meeting.
  - O March reports reflect Show & Banquet income & expenses. Next month's report will show Banquet meals income/expense as a pass-through item.
  - o All but \$45 of the uncollected Banquet sales were received in follow-up effort.
  - Bryan Tudor is now coordinating the financial responsibilities at the monthly meeting.
  - Mike Rubush proposed accepting the Treasurer's report. The motion was seconded by Jeff McElravy. The motion carried.

#### **Action Items:**

- Audit team financial audit summary Jim Klosterman
  - The conclusion from the audit team is that Bob has done a great job in providing information for the audit team. He also has performed a commendable performance in managing the finances of the club.
  - Jim recommended a separate person should handle the cash at general membership meetings other than the Treasurer. This maintains checks and balances in handling funds.
  - A final audit letter was provided at the meeting.
  - Steve Baily recommended accepting the financial audit report. The motion was seconded by Jim Boude. The motion was passed.
- 2018 BUFF Philanthropy List
  - A list of recommended contributions to philanthropy was provided.

- Bob recommends a strategy of reducing contributions to philanthropy so that a slight profit can be budgeted. This slight profit will be in contrast to the actual losses over the past couple of years. The proposed contribution is \$500 less than prior year contribution of \$5700.
- The Board discussed if BUFF was contributing to government funded agencies. In particular the following four agencies were questions: Clermont Soil & Water Conservation, Little Miami Conservancy, Mill Creek Watershed Council, Scenic Rivers Protection Fund.
- o Jim Boude proposed to approve funding of all philanthropy items with the exception of the four agencies that may be government funded.

The proposal was passed.

- The four agencies will be investigated to prevent using BUFF funds to monetarily support government activities.
- Storage locker keys
  - o Mike Redmond (key owner) will provide a key to Tom Bachey for club use.

#### **Updates:**

- Forum discussion
  - A preamble was posted on the BUFF Forum website. Members have noticed and provided positive comments about the statement. Activity has increased since the update.
- BUFF Banquet (Bryan T. & Bob G.)
  - New leadership for the Banquet is desired to relieve some long term leadership of the Banquet.
  - o The net income for this year's Banquet was \$8508.68.
- Fly Fishing Show
  - O Dave Hughes will be the headliner for the Show. Bob Miller is confirming all details for the speaking engagement.
  - O A preliminary list of presenters & demonstrators is under development.
  - o Booth prices for 2019 have increased 12% from last year (to \$1.25/sq ft).
  - o Booth layouts will be optimized to improve visibility and traffic flow in 2019.
  - Booth sales will start May 1.
  - Next team meeting is scheduled for June 5<sup>th</sup>.
- Volunteer hour recording requirement is needed for organizational and government reporting.
  - Bob stated that Ohio State government wants to know the number of hours that the BOD volunteers for the club.
  - o BUFF is a member of IFF. This organization keeps records and uses it in public presentations and funding requests Jeff McElravy
    - The BUFF volunteer record keeping will be managed by Ken Dixon.
    - The times of interest are teaching, external service or administrative time of leaders.
    - The completed hours should be sent to Ken Dixon in a simple email.
