#### **Administrative Items:**

  - o Mike Redmond operation was today
- July BOD meeting minutes approval
  - Jim Boude proposed accepting the July 2016 minutes. The motion was seconded by Jeff McElravy, and it was approved.
- Treasurer's Report (Bob G.)
  - o Financial reports were sent to BOD in prior email
  - Income through July is 33,894 (at 96.4% of budget forecast); Expenses were \$31,906)
    at (80% of budget forecast)
  - Low financial activity in July in part is the result of joint meeting with NKFF in Kentucky
  - Checking account signatories were updated to include Paul Juszczyk and to renew J.R.
    Jackson and Bob Gustafson
  - o 'Cash Flow' for the club was handed out

#### **Action Items:**

- Discussion of logo wear (Sue Jones)
  - 'Hero Patches' is vendor that can make patches for the club at a low cost of \$1.50. In prior years, the cost of the patch was \$5.00. Sue would need at least \$157 to purchase the patches.
  - A motion to authorize Sue Jones to spend up to \$200 for advanced purchase of club patches was made by Steve Bailey and seconded by Jim Boude. The motion was approved.
  - A motion to sell patch for \$3.00 per patch was made by Ed Jones and seconded by Jim Boude. The motion was approved.
- Dues schedule follow-up from July meeting (Bob G)
  - The board discussed methods to simplify our complicated monthly schedule fees.
  - A proposal to set the annual membership at \$25 per year for individual and \$30 per year for Family independent of the month the member joins was made by Steve Bailey and seconded by Jim Boude.

- The new member fee of \$5 and one time PHW \$10 fee is still in effect. The membership starts from January 1<sup>st</sup> with grace period till the March meeting. The proposal would start Jan 1, 2017.
