- Previous month's meeting minutes approval
 - Bob G Gustafson proposed accepting last month's Minutes. This motion was seconded by Don Kail and passed by Board.
- Treasurer's Report (Bob G.)
 - November financial report emailed prior to meeting
 - o Membership Renewals by Paypal are at a record pace
 - o Auditors needed for 2019 Audit
 - Cari Vota will assist
 - Ken Mandel proposed accepting the Treasurer's Report. This motion was seconded by Mike Rubush and passed by the Board.

New Business

- Project Healing Waters update (Brent Miller)
 - PHW in Cincinnati / NK is going through a transition. PHW issued a Memorandum of Agreement for 230 programs to legally have one organization lead each Vet group. In Cincinnati, both NKFF and BUFF co-lead the group. This will not be accepted by PHW in the future.
 - NKFF was offered their own program or offered to continue as volunteers to the BUFF PHW lead group.
 - Currently, there are 32 volunteers from NKFF & BUFF serving 25 registered Vets.
 Sixteen (16) volunteers are from NKFF and may be lost; There are 4 7 vets in KY who might leave and join NKFF PHW group, if created in the future.

- A means to expand the Cincinnati Vet group could be to add a Saturday program to attract new volunteers and vets. This option could be alternating Tuesday and Saturday dates or a switch to Saturday dates. This option would be good for veterans and volunteers who work and cannot attend the weekday sessions. As an example, Indianapolis PHW runs a very successful program on Saturdays.
- BUFF has budget line for PHW. However, non-profit to non-profit expenses should be avoided for tax status reasons. A donation from a non-profit to a non-profit is perfectly fine and acceptable. This should be the means that BUFF uses to financially support PHW if needed. The expense line has not been used in some time.
- New life members (Jeff M)
 - Jeff is leading a committee to examine new lifetime membership (LTM). We currently have two potential openings. The committee recommends only filling one position at this time.
 - There will be a vote on at the January meeting for a new LTM. Please attend.
- Discussion centered on collecting (or not collecting) from individuals who signed up for meeting meals but who missed the meeting. This discussion was triggered by an individual who mailed in a meal payment for the meal that was missed. The result of discussion is that the club will accept the check as part of the effort to balance the dinner budget.
- Security needed for website. A budget element of \$85 is needed. Jim Boude motioned to add this budget item. The motion was seconded by Bob Gustafson and it was passed by the Board.
