12 Board members called to order at 6:34 pm.

Administration Items:

- Membership health concerns? Is there anyone to whom we need to send a BUFF card?
 - o Jeff McElravy / Harry Ludlow
- December BOD Meeting Minutes approval
 - A motion to accept the December 2015 minutes was proposed by Don Kail and seconded by Jim Boude. The motion passed.
- Treasurer Reports
 - o Three financial spreadsheets were sent previous via email to the BOD. The club had a net income \$3,083.25 for the 2015 year.
 - The club auditing process requires two club auditors. We need one volunteer from BOD and Steve Bailey has stepped forward for the BOD position. We need one volunteer who is not on the BOD. Bob Gustafson will ask Steve Alexander and/or George Fraley if one of them would be the second member of the Audit Committee.
 - o Will capitalize library to fixed assets based on Fair Market Value.
 - A motion to accept the financial reports was proposed by Don Kail and seconded by Sue Jones. The motion was passed.

Action Items:

- PHW Revisit reduced fees to members of PHW Dixon
 - Last month, the BOD voted to provide a discount to Vets from PHW on a year by year basis.
 - Brent Miller, program leader for PHW, spoke to the BOD and asked for a first year discount. Brent described the purposed and benefits of PHW:
 - Physical and emotional health of veterans
 - Desire for the vets to grow by facing new challenges and associations
 - Expansion of association from PHW to local club is a good step forward
 - The recommendation is to offer a reduced first year membership with waiver of initiation fee. This is a modification of last month's motion to extend reduced fees indefinitely.
 - o The above motion was proposed by Ed Jones and seconded by Jim Neckers. The motion was passed thus replacing last month's motion.
- January Meetings Notifications to Membership
 - Send out member email reminder for the not standard January meeting date: 3rd week of January for the general meeting.

- Donation to Au Sable Anglers Ed Jones
 - Ed Jones brought a stream issue in Michigan to the attention of the BOD. The stream is the Au Sable and fish farm is now authorized to discharge untreated fish farm effluent into a branch stream immediately above the nine mile catch and release stretch that is known as the 'holy water'. This untreated effluent has been authorized by the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ).

 - o This trout river is fished by a number of people in the club.
 - A MDEQ hearing will be held February 8-12, 2016 and the Au Stable Angler's Association is taking donations to mount a legal defense of the river quality.
 - o Ed recommended a donation of \$1000 to the legal defense fund: "Hatchery Litigation Donation".
 - o Tim Williamson motioned for this recommendation and this motion was seconded by Don Kail. The motion was passed.
 - Ken asked for volunteer to draft a letter to inform our membership about this fishing quality threat. Ed will prepare the letter.
- Elections: BOD Award & Lifetime Membership
 - LTM: Sue recommended offering 2 positions. This recommendation was proposed by George Hupp and seconded by Jim Boude. The motion passed.
 - A vote for two lifetime memberships was conducted by the board. The voting rules included the following:
 - Each person will be independently elected: Yes / No for each person.
 - Voters must be current board member to vote.
 - o BOD Award: One award for BOD was voted from a list of 4 nominees
