Arkansas Trout Trip, Heber Springs, Arkansas October 28th – November 4th, 2006

The fifth BUFF trip to the Little Red River in Heber Springs was again an extraordinary adventure as our group of seven ventured into the beautiful Ozark mountain ranges of Arkansas.

For seven days we fished the dam area, Cowl Shoals, Winkley Shoals at the Swinging Bridge, Libby Shoals, and took a day trip up to the Norfork River in Mountain View. In all of these places we hooked into rainbows, browns and a few brook trout at the dam. The Swinging Bridge seemed to produce the most fish, rainbows predominated. A couple of days into the trip Bruce James and Frank Skufca eventually found the "honey hole" at the Swinging bridge and proceeded to catch rainbows at leisure on a fly called "the fifty sixer" Check your local fly shop or ask Bruce for the pattern. Fritz Backscheider and Tom Scheer did a lot of fishing together taking in a guided trip that landed them lots of rainbows and several big browns…a trip well recommended for the newcomer to the area. By the way, Fritz caught the largest fish of the trip with a 23 inch brown. Congrats Fritz!! Gary Cummins drove five of us to the Norfork on Tuesday. Driving through the country roads to Mountain View was just absolutely beautiful during this foliage time of year. We hit the colors at a good time. The Norfork produced fish but not the big ones we thought we would catch. Again, Bruce seemed to have the touch, both rainbows and browns.

Everyone caught lots of fish, some more than others. Gary Cummins and John Fecker teamed up to explore the area and Gary showed John where some of the beauty of this area is located. John sure liked to work the streams and would be gone hours at a time trying to catch his fair share. We became regulars at the new fly shop in town, The Little Red Fly Shop, located near the Swinging Bridge. Jed, the manager, instructed a couple of us on how to fish a soft hackle through the shallow currents and catch fish. His technique worked and we had a blast catching fish in waters that we passed over because we didn't know how to fish it.

Our accommodations were very good and very affordable. We negotiated a weekly rate of \$250 per room that had two double beds and was clean as a whistle. Divide that by two for seven nights and you can't live at home for that price. Area restaurants were inexpensive and the food was good.

Give it some thought for next year, as this is truly a first class fishery. Contact any of us and we will tell you some more good stories.



Directions:

From I-275 – Take Exit 46, (US 42), south for three miles to Glendale-Milford Rd. --Continue south and RAFFEL'S will be on the left approximately 3/10 mile.

From I-75 -- Take Exit 14, east, on Glendale-Milford Rd. until the intersection of US 42, (Reading Rd). Turn right (south) on US 42, and RAFFEL'S will be on the left approximately 3/10 mile.

From I-71 -- Take Exit 15, west, Pfeiffer Rd. & this becomes Glendale-Milford Rd.. At the intersection of US 42, (Reading Rd), turn left, (south) on US 42, and RAFFEL'S will be on the left approximately 3/10 mile.
