## Fly Fishing 101 Course March 2011 Lou Haynes

The BUFF Fly Fishing 101 Course will be held in March at the Springdale Community Center located at 11999 Lawnview Avenue in Springdale (behind the Outback Restaurant near Rt. 4 and I-275). The classes will be held on the four Thursday evenings in March (3, 10, 17 and 24) and will run from 6:30 PM to 8:30 PM. This course is open to BUFF members "only"; there is no fee to attend. The information presented is designed for beginners and intermediate-skilled fishers. If you have an interest in the course I encourage you to register even if you can't come to all 4 classes. You can catch-up buy reviewing the notes from the classes you miss.

The course material will cover rods, reels, backing, lines, leaders, tippets, recommended flies to get you started, fly fishing knots, how to select a fly rod system to meet your fishing needs, other equipment needs and casting basics.

#### **Course Outline:**

- ✓ Class 1. Lines, rods, reels and backing.
- ✓ Class 2. Leaders, tippets, how to select a fly fishing system to meet your fishing needs, how to correctly put your system together and take it apart, fly line cleaning, recommended flies to get you started and fly fishing terms.
- ✓ Class 3. Leader designs, knots, hooks and additional equipment needs
- ✓ Class 4. Casting basics & demonstrations, casting video.

## WHAT HAPPENED TO THE ZEBRAS? Steve Lilly

On March 27, 2007, the Army Corps of Engineers reduced the outflow for the Ceasar Creek Dam from 1225cfs to 238cfs. This caused the creek below the dam to drop from a gage height of 9.2 ft to 6.4ft, almost 3 feet. As the creek receded from the bank, several million zebra mussels became stranded. These zebra mussels were so thick, they were virtually shoulder to shoulder all along the edge of the creek, and in some spots were bunched up three or four deep. All of them were alive because Zebra mussels can live for weeks out of the water. Although they attach themselves to whatever solid objects are available, such as intake pipes, these zebra's were not attached to anything. They don't have any appendage like a foot for locomotion as many mussels do, but sometimes they will bunch up in a ball and let the current roll them along. Many such balls of zebras could be found along the creek bank. All of these stranded zebras were waiting for the water to rise so that they could get on with things. In addition to the stranded zebras, many more were still in the stream, and were firmly attached to the stream substrate by way of their byssal threads.

All summer long, anyone wading in the creek could easily find lots of zebra mussels attached to the rocks all along the creek bottom. If a rock were lifted from the stream, many zebras of all sizes could be found on the rock's underside.

However, by November there wasn't a zebra to be found anywhere in Ceasar Creek. They are not on or under any rocks. Maybe one or two could be found in a backwater, some distance from the main stream, but otherwise they were all gone. What happened to all those millions of zebras that were so prevalent in the early spring?

I think it would be enjoyable and useful for 2011 BUFF members to help create the BUFF Ultimate Fly Box. It will be a collection of BUFF members' favorite flies which work for different species that will be viewable at the BUFF website. Current BUFF members will be allowed to submit to me via email descriptions of two of their favorite flies. Members who do not have email can send their descriptions to me on a DVD via the U.S. mail or give it to me at a BUFF meeting. The description must include a picture of the fly (jpeg file), tying directions – a simple listing of materials in the order used, species caught on the fly, and comments (if any), a *brief* note the submitter may want to add to the description. Please add your full name to the description in case it is not included with your email address. And please put the names of your two flies in the title of your email to me. Ken Foltz has graciously consented to use the information provided to design the BUFF Ultimate Fly Box on the BUFF website. Thanks Ken! If two people send in the same fly description, the fly shown in the Ultimate Fly Box will be credited to the first submitter. Depending on the response we hope to continue to add to the BUFF Ultimate Fly Box in the future.

Beginning now you can send your fly descriptions to me at your convenience. As you can imagine if there is a big initial response my mail box can get shut down. If that happens you will be automatically informed about it and you will have to resend your email at a later time. As long as I am home I will make every attempt to put fly descriptions on a DVD and free up email space ASAP. 
