Alex's background in teaching and education have made him a great fly fishing instructor and guide. Alex is the owner of AB Guide service out of Sylva, North Carolina.


Alex will be speaking about the Western North Carolina Fly Fishing Trail and fishing the Tuckasegee River's Delayed harvest waters. In 2009, the Jackson County Tourism Authority asked Alex to help develop the trout trail. He readily agreed to the project and served as co-creator of the trail. The initiative sought to connect more anglers with the waters Alex loves.

The trail connects anglers with 15 prime fishing locations across Jackson County, and is the first fly fishing trail in the United States.

Many of our BUFF members have learned to effectively fish the Tuckasegee (Tuck) with Alex at their side.


