



Russell Blessing's Wooly Bugger

Materials:

Daiichi 1530 size 10 (or similar)

Black 6/0 thread

Small grizzly hackle

Purple ultra chenille

Tying directions:

Place hook in vise.

Wrap shank with thread from behind eye to hook bend.

Extend grizzly hackle about 1/2 inch beyond hook bend and tie in at hook bend.

Tie in purple ultra chenille at hook bend and wrap shank with it to 1/8 inch behind eye.

Palmer grizzly hackle forward and tie off.

Whip finish head.

Comments: very effective fly for catching large bluegills

Species caught: bluegill and largemouth bass
