



Dragon Fly

Tying materials listed in the order used.

Hook: Mustad 3XL size 8 (or similar)

Thread: brown 3/0

Body: pencil width portion of natural deer hair approx. 1 ½ inches long, centered on hook shank with hair facing forward, then tied down about 1/4 inch behind hook eye, thread taken forward to hook eye, then taken back 1/4/inch, deer hair pulled back, tied down to give a head approx. ¼ inch long, thread palmered toward rear for approx. 1/4 inch, then palmered forward to back of head

Tail: length is approx. 3/4 inch

Hackle: brown, four turns at back of head

Head: coated with Hard as Nails

Comments: total length of fly is approx. 1 ¼ inches

Species caught: bluegills, largemouth bass
