

McFly Spawn

Tying Materials

Hook: size 10-12 scud hook

Thread: 6/0 red

Body: two strands of McFly Foam, color of choice; pearl, tan, chartreuse and orange are most effective

Tying Directions

1. Wrap thread behind eye to past bend in hook.
2. Tie on two long strands of McFly Foam at back of hook shank, with long strands hanging toward front.
3. Make a small loop on far side of hook and tie off. Do the same thing on the near side of the hook. Make progressively larger loops as you work toward the front of the hook with one smaller loop on each side right behind the hook eye (usually 4 loops is sufficient on size 10-12 hooks).
4. Tie off.

Comments: fish this fly dead drift; preferred locations are tailout areas and the heads of pools.

Species caught: steelhead, rainbow trout
